DAY 5



This trip will bring us to Porto, the capital of the north which is best known for two things: its river, the Douro, and its port. The most spectacular attraction near Porto is the Douro Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where wine has been produced for centuries. Then, we will head to Lisbon the Portugal's hilly, coastal capital city. From imposing São Jorge Castle, the view encompasses the old city's pastel-colored buildings, Tagus Estuary and Ponte 25 de Abril suspension bridge.

Day 1. MADRID - SALAMANCA - PORTO

Departure from our bus terminal to begin our journey to Salamanca. Brief stop to walk through this monumental city and its famous Plaza Mayor. We will continue our journey across the Portuguese borders crossing the International bridge over the Minho River. Arrival to Oporto, dinner and accommodations.

Day 2. PORTO - COIMBRA - FATIMA

Breakfast. Morning city sightseeing tour of this charming city by the Douro. Famous because of its denomination of origin wines, its bridges, the coast, Cathedral, San Francisco church and the Palacio da Bolsa. Continue to Coimbra, site of one of the oldest universities in Europe and birthplace of Fado. Free time, in the afternoon continuation to Fatima. Dinner and accommodations.

Day 3. FATIMA - LISBON

Breakfast. Time at leisure to visit the Shrine of this important pilgrimage center. In the afternoon departure to Lisbon, the capital of Portugal. This journey could be optionally operated visiting the Batalha Monastery, located in the small fishing village of Nazaré and the beautiful city of Odivos. Arrival to Lisbon and accommodations.

Day 4. LISBON

Breakfast and accommodations. Morning city sightseeing tour: old Alfama Quarter, Tower of Belem, Monastery of Los Jeronimos, etc. Afternoon at leisure. Optional tour to Sintra, Cascais and Estoril. Return to our hotel in Lisbon and overnight accommodations.

Day 5. LISBON - CACERES - MADRID

Breakfast. Departure to the border with Spain and continuation to Caceres. Time at leisure to know its Plaza Mayor and to walk through the old city and its famous medieval quarter, very well preserved and considered as World Heritage place. Lunch at your own.
