

# MADRID 4 DAYS



This trip will bring us to Madrid the capital and most populous city of Spain. Madrid has preserved the look and feel of many of its historic neighborhoods and streets. Its landmarks include the Plaza Mayor, the Royal Palace of Madrid; the Royal Theatre with its restored 1850 Opera House; the Buen Retiro Park, founded in 1631; the 19th-century National Library building, founded in 1712, containing some of Spain's historical archives. It's renowned for its rich repositories of European art, including the Prado Museum's works by Goya, Velázquez and other Spanish masters. Cibeles Palace and Fountain have become one of the monument symbols of the city.

## 1st day: Hometown-Madrid

Arrival in Madrid international airport. Transfer to hotel in Madrid. Welcome in the hotel by English speaking guide who will assist you for the check in. Dinner near your hotel.

## 2nd day: Madrid

After breakfast, you will enjoy Madrid City Tour with panoramic bus. Lunch on your own. In the afternoon, you will visit the Prado Museum where you can meet Goya, Velázquez, Titian, Rubens and Hieronymus Bosch, among other masters. Dinner on your own.

## 3rd day: Madrid

After breakfast, you will visit the traditional Madrid. you should start at **Puerta del Sol**, where you can spot the statue of the Bear and the Strawberry Tree, Mariblanca, Casa de Correos and the legendary Tío Pepe neon sign. The itinerary continues in **Plaza Mayor**, where history spans four centuries, and then in **Plaza de la Villa**, the beating heart of the city in the Middle Ages, where you can still see some of the oldest buildings: the Lujanes House and Tower, the Cisneros House and Casa de la Villa.

Madrid's cathedral, **La Almudena**, is a pebble's throw from here. Next to the cathedral you can still find the remains of the Arab city walls and, of course, the **Royal Palace**, which is worth a visit. When you get out, take a few minutes off at the **Sabatini Gardens** or **Campo del Moro Park**, a large English-style garden by the Royal Palace. Lunch in a traditional Spanish restaurant. Free time in the afternoon to relax or do shopping.

## 4th day: Madrid-Hometown

Transfer to Madrid international airport.
